

ONCE UPON A TOWN

Ormskirk 100 Years From Now

You are invited to imagine Ormskirk 100 years from now, create your own artwork and contribute to an animated installation (inspired by your submitted work). The animation will be installed in a pop-up space in Ormskirk town centre.

Upload images of your artwork and they will be included in the online exhibition "One Hundred Years from Now", to be showcased in the Grand Hall in the Clock Tower, a virtual museum and Gallery.



1) Ask yourself the question what will Ormskirk look like?

To consider what the Town Centre could look like in one hundred years, have a think about who uses the Town Centre, what age groups and what they use it for? Then think about how the space and how it is used, what the buildings are like now and could be like in the future, many were designed in the last century.

Now you have the freedom to create a new town centre designed for people who will use it for play, work, shopping and leisure, catering for all their needs. Where will we live, what kinds of places will there be and how will we get there?

Use your imagination to draw, build, describe or model your Ormskirk in 100 years' time.

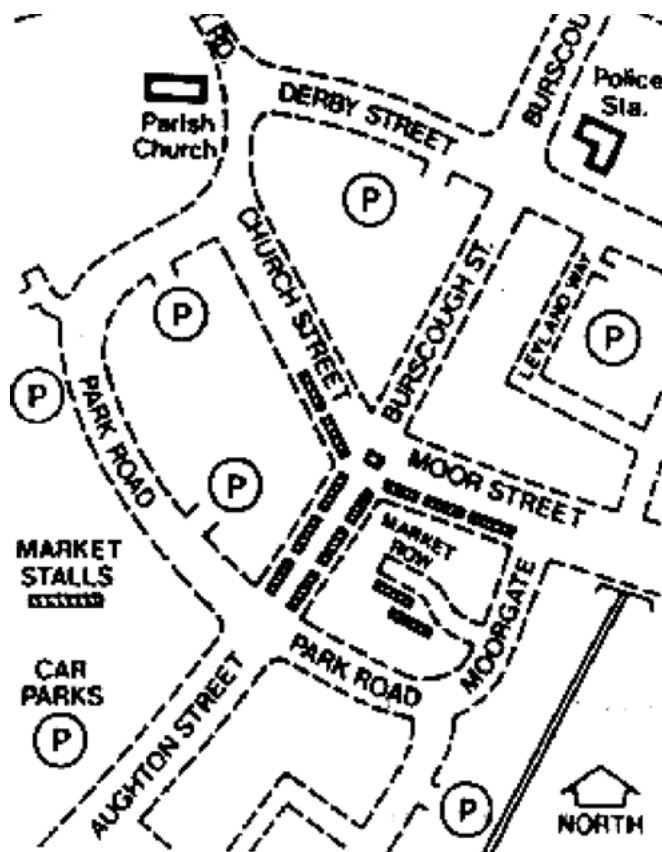
Let your imagination get the better of you and think about how you would like to live, play and socialise in the future.

All entries will receive a bronze, silver, or gold certificate and be exhibited either in the Chapel- Ormskirk Art House or Online.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be awarded a prize in the two age groups 7 – 11 or 12 – 16 of vouchers for £50, £25 or £15 respectively.
